20. ___ Catching up of church is before the tribulation. Separate from coming in judgment
21. ___ Catching up of church is in the middle of the tribulation. Separate from coming in judgment
22. ___ Catching up of the church is after the tribulation. Single-event coming
23. ___ Christ's second coming in judgment
24. ___ A time of great trouble immediately before the coming of Christ. Preterists believe it is past. Futurists believe it is future
